We are committed to providing a safe and positive environment for everyone. We want those that play here to learn about teamwork, sportsmanship and fair play. As such, we have zero tolerance for inappropriate behaviour and we request that spectators participate in the following code of conduct:

- Display good sportsmanship. Always respect players, coaches, officials and volunteers.
- Act appropriately; do not taunt or disturb other fans; enjoy the game together.
- Refrain from comments or actions that are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist, or sexist. Behavior that constitutes harassment or abuse (as defined by Hockey Canada and Hockey Nova Scotia) will not be tolerated by the facility or Acadia Minor Hockey Association.
- Support the officials and coaches by trusting their judgment and integrity.
- Be responsible for your own safety - - be alert to prevent accidents from flying pucks and other avoidable situations.
- Respect locker rooms as private areas for players, coaches, and officials.
- Be supportive after the game – win or lose. Recognize good effort, teamwork and sportsmanship.
