



Acadia Minor Hockey Association Jersey Policy



Jerseys are a shared responsibility of the Head Coach and Manager of each team. The Manager will be expected to maintain a record of each player's number and contact information.

Jersey Distribution

- The Team Manager will hand out the jerseys at the start of the season and document the information on the Jersey Sign out form & email a copy of the sign out form to: AMHAASSETS@OUTLOOK.COM

Jersey Care

- Jerseys are not to be left in hockey bags. Damp or sweaty shirts are susceptible to staining and mold, which make them unusable and undesirable to wear.
- Launder jerseys in cold water, **inside-out** as required and **hang to dry**.
- AMHA Jerseys are for games only please. To keep the life of the jerseys longer, AMHA asks all teams to use practice jerseys for practices and to save AMHA Jerseys for Home and Away games.
- Colors for AMHA name bars are: Red **with white lettering**, and Blue **with white lettering**.
- Blue name bars on blue jerseys, Red name bars on red jerseys.
- Name bars to be stitched on by a professional tailor/seamstress.
- No adhesive is to be used on any AMHA jersey.
- Name bars are to be attached to the top of the jersey.
- Player name bar must match the name on the Team roster.
- Removal of name bars are to be done by a professional **tailor/seamstress**.

Jersey Collection

- At the end of the season after name bars have been removed by the appropriate AMHA tailor; jerseys must be washed and returned to the team's Head Coach and/or Manager no later than April 15th.
- The Manager/Head Coach are to return both sets of jerseys to the Chair of Physical Assets no later than April 15th of the current season. Collection dates will be posted on the website. The Chair of Physical Assets WILL NOT accept partial returns of jerseys, the Manager/ Head Coach will be turned away at collection without a complete set of Home/Away jerseys.
- Jerseys that are not returned or damaged will be charged **\$60 per jersey** and will be required to be paid prior to registration for the following year. Exception: if a jersey is damaged or cut during a game the Head Coach must notify the Chair of Physical Assets ASAP to make arrangements for replacement. Families will not be responsible for replacement costs under these circumstances.
